\$142,290 to 172 students Student Adoption Program's (S.A.P.) mission is to assist students in their preparation for and pursuit of postsecondary education. The Student Assistance Fund (S.A.F.), a part of the Student Adoption Program, was created to offer financial, social, emotional and spiritual assistance to college students. S.A.F. recipients are required to attend annual interviews, submit grades and receipts for items purchased with funds.

\$21,750 to 14 scholars A Hezekiah Brady, Jr. Scholarship recipient must be an active, current S.A.F. member, at least a college sophomore and have a minimum 3.0 GPA. He/she must submit a 400 to 500 word biographical essay and recommendations from college professors. Holding a leadership role in an organization is also a prerequisite for being considered for the scholarship.

The C.R.A.F.T. organization just began another school year in partnership with the Lorenzo Smith School through the *Eagles Program*. The mission of the Eagles Program is to build self-esteem and self worth in Pembroke Township youth by providing role models, leadership and guidance for the students.

efore they are awarded the Student Assistance Funds, the students must attend an interview with members of the Board of Directors and staff from the C.R.A.F.T. organization. Time is spent getting to know the students and then they are asked to answer and discuss a series of questions on topics such as: time management, extra-curricular activities they are involved in, issues they may be confronted with at college, how they have adapted to college life, and future plans after graduation.
